This study will be comparing features of autism, gender dysphoria and OCD between different diagnostic groups. Participants will be asked to complete three questionnaires. In total, this study should take up to 15 minutes to complete. The questionnaires will measure Autistic traits, Obsessive and Compulsive traits, and Gender Dysphoric issues. Questionnaires will be completed online and can be completed at a location chosen by the participant but we encourage participation within your own home. Participant information and data will be confidential, and all information will be treated in the strictest confidence and according to legal and ethical guidelines.

We do not anticipate any disadvantages in taking part in this study. If there are any questions you wish to not answer, you can choose to not answer it. Although there may not be any direct benefit to you from participating in this study, we would be very grateful for your contribution. Your participation is completely voluntary and you are free to withdraw from the study at any time during data collection without giving a reason. If you wish to withdraw from the study before completion, simply close your web browser. Your data will be anonymous, and as a result of this it will not be possible to withdraw individual research data upon completion of the study.
